The Maastricht courses will have to contribute to the integrated Bocconi degree (Laurea Magistrale in Giurisprudenza) as well, so be sure that you have a valid learning agreement!

You need to choose the general programme or chose the specialisation European Business Law or the specialisation European Public Law. Make sure that your course combination meets the requirements mentioned below.
